

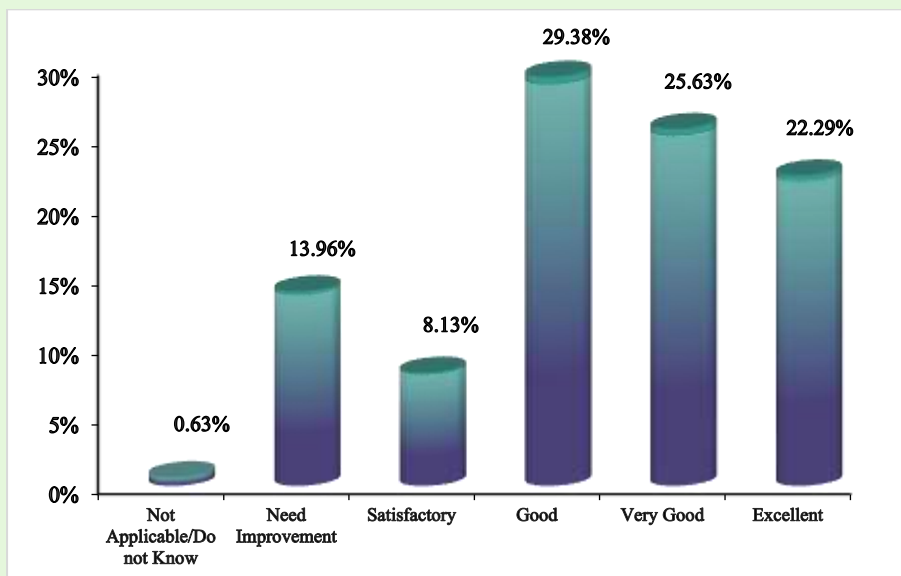

Evaluation of Feedback from Parents 2023-2024



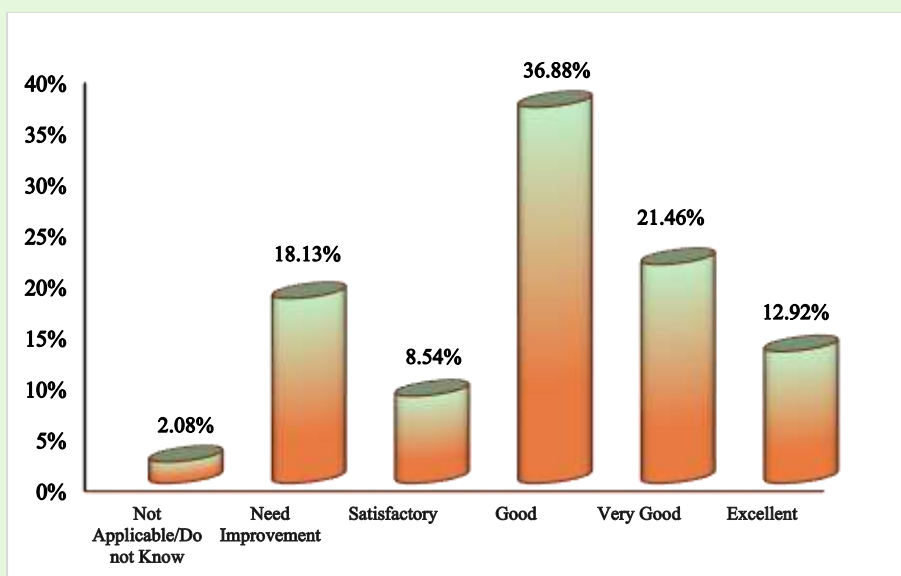
1. Quality of Teaching/ Faculty

2. Academic Environment/Lab facilities

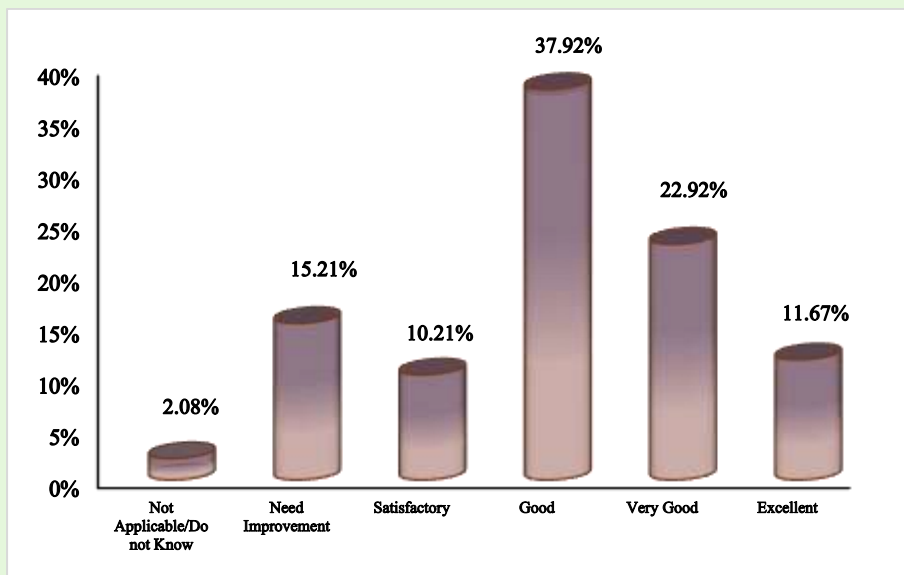


Action Taken:-

- Installed interactive smart boards in select classrooms



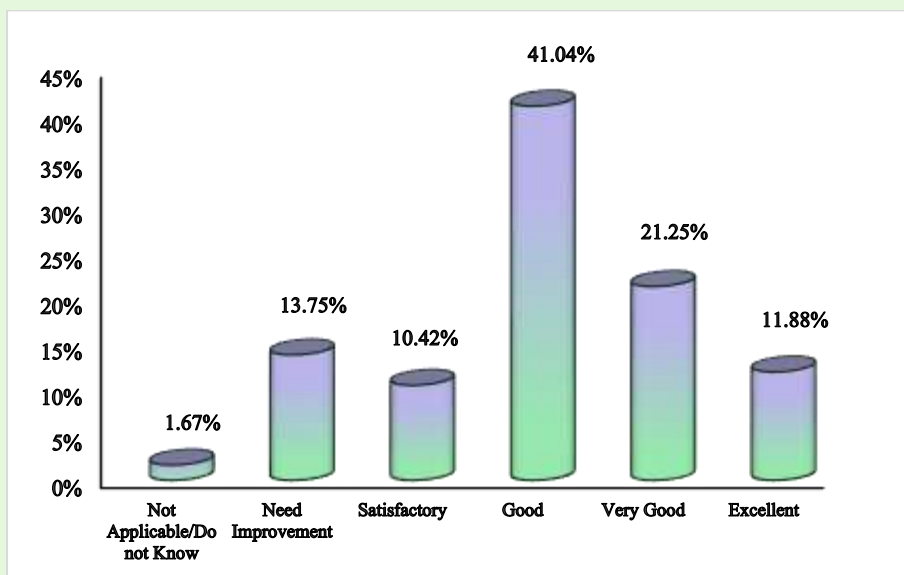
3. Holistic development of student/ ward

4. Students' Grievances Handling

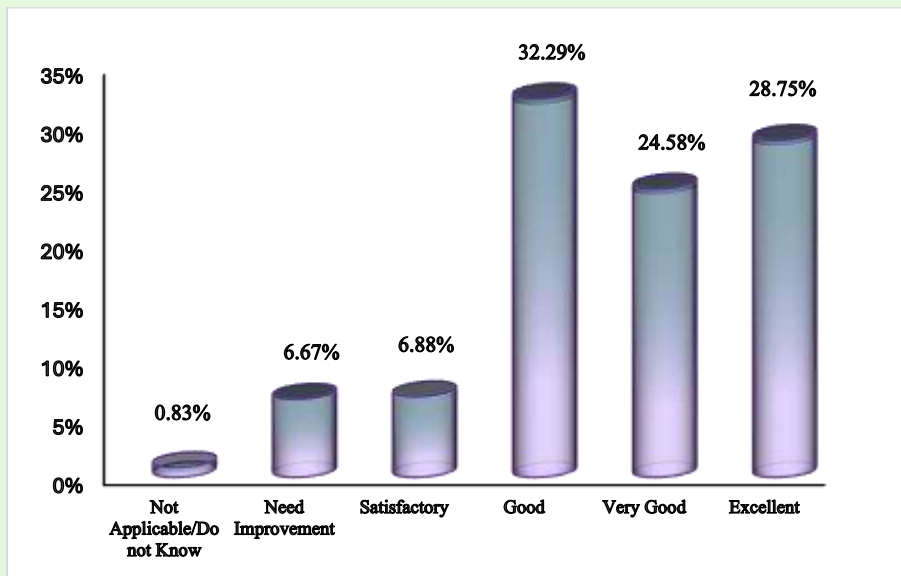


Action Taken: -

- Ensured time-bound resolutions with regular monitoring by faculty coordinators



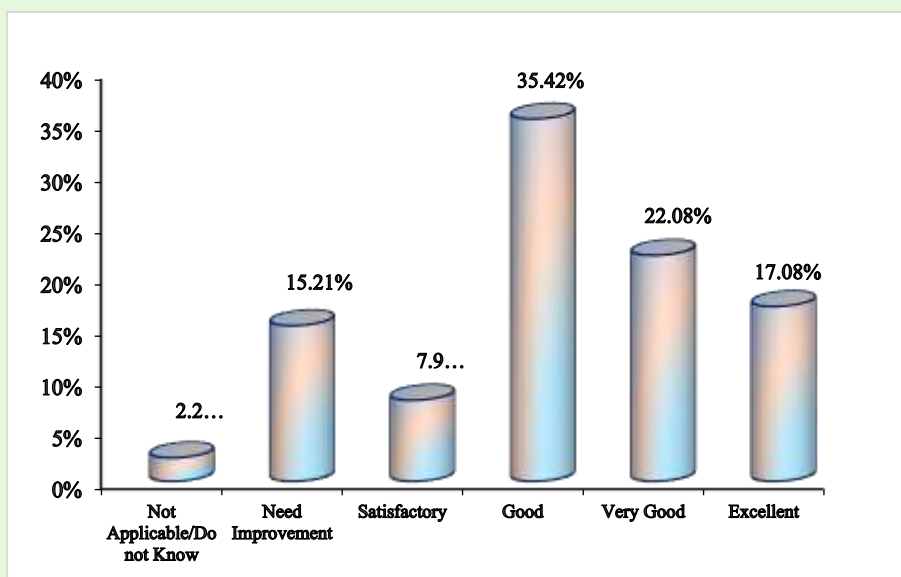
5. Information to parents about wards' attendance/performance

6. General Environment and Discipline in the College

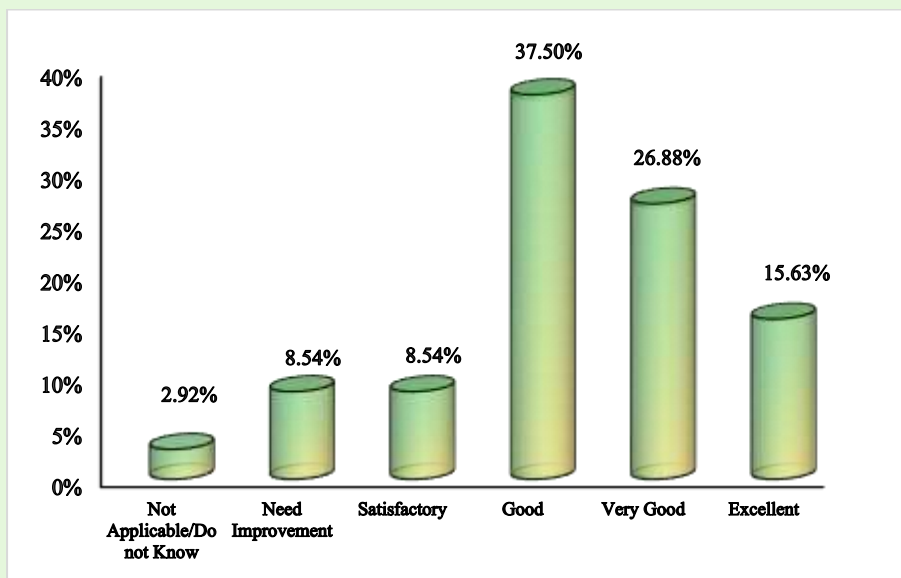


Action Taken: -

- Conducted frequent surprise inspections for discipline.



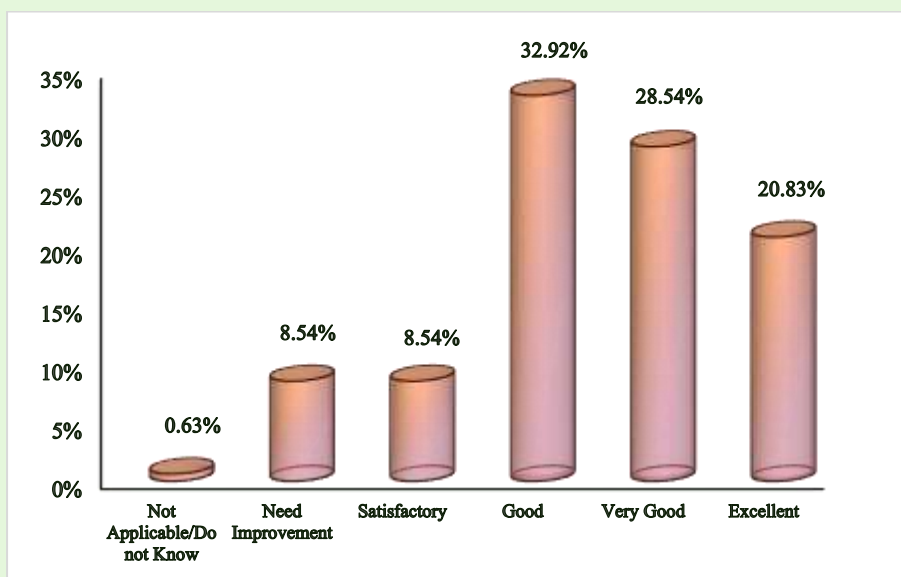
7. Parent Teacher interaction system

8. General Behavior of Teachers during your visit

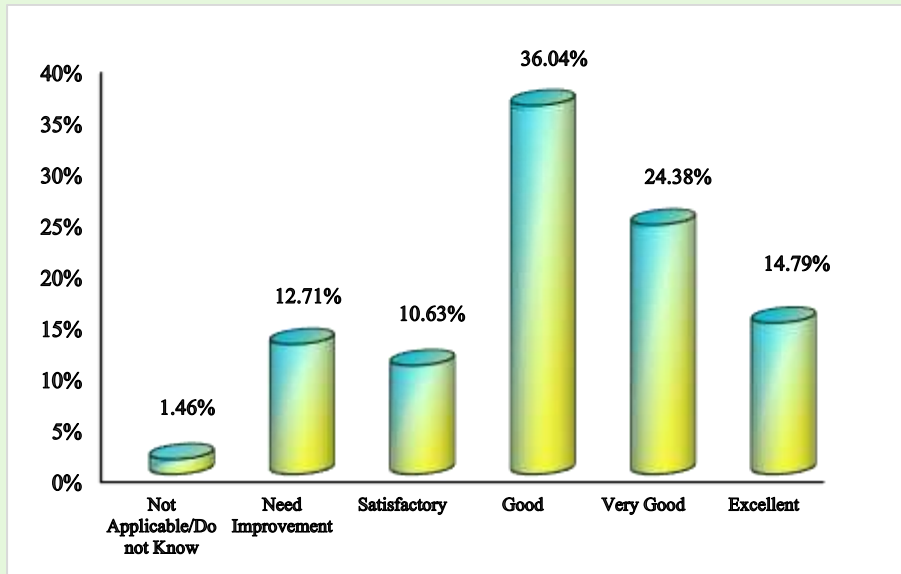


Action Taken:-

- Issued faculty conduct guidelines for interactions during official visits and PTMs.



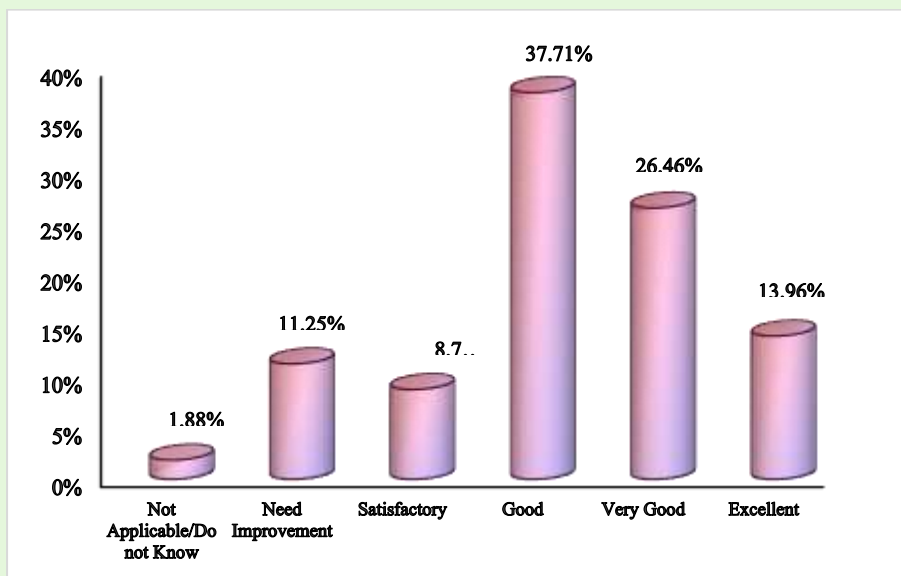
9. General Behavior of non-teaching staff during your visit
