The following points were discussed and resolved. The meeting began with a warm welcome from Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Gupta, Principal, Aggarwal college Ballabgarh who extend greetings to the coordinators and members of IIC from college.

Objectives of the Meeting:

- Planned activities for the Quarter-III

Review of Previous Meeting:

Ms. Dolly Mangla provided a concise summary of the key discussions and decisions from the previous IIC meeting, which focused on Ideathon 1.0 and encouraging idea generation for growth and creativity.

Planned activities for the upcoming months (March-May 2026):

- During the meeting, **Mr. Sarthak** presented his innovative idea titled “**Collie Connect**”, a digital platform designed to assist passengers in improving travel connectivity and coordination. The idea focuses on creating a convenient system that can help passengers connect, share travel information, and enhance overall travel experience through better communication and accessibility. After detailed discussion and feedback from the members, the council suggested further refinement of the concept to enhance its applicability and impact.
- The council members decided to enroll more students and teachers to enroll in innovation ambassador training to cultivate the culture of entrepreneurship.
- The council also resolved that official communications/emails will be sent to different universities, including Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU), to invite faculty members and students for academic and innovation visits, inter-institutional interaction, and participation in IIC activities. It was unanimously decided that each IIC member will bring unique and innovative ideas in the next IIC meeting for discussion, evaluation, and possible implementation.
- The council proposed organizing a session on the **Business Model Canvas** to provide students with a clear understanding of how to design and structure a business model. The session will explain important elements such as the value proposition, customer segments, revenue streams, cost structure, and key partnerships.
- The council also planned to conduct a practical workshop focusing on **fundraising strategies and financial management for start-ups**. The workshop will cover topics such as sources of start-up funding, pitching to investors, budgeting, financial planning, and managing start-up finances efficiently.

Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Gupta thanked all the members for their enthusiastic participation and particularly acknowledged the valuable insights and suggestions provided by the external experts. The next meeting is **tentatively scheduled for June 2026**, during which the council will review the progress of the ongoing initiatives and continue brainstorming additional ways to enhance the impact of the IIC.
